Australians lost over \$634 million to scams in 2019, this is a 30 per cent increase on 2018. Scammers use personal data to steal identities, open loans, and steal or launder money. Australians are being urged to watch out for government impersonation scams as well as scammers using the spread of COVID-19 to take advantage of people. Scammers are hoping that you have let your guard down during these uncertain times, so be sure not to provide your personal, banking, superannuation details or remote access to your computer to anyone. Scammers often pretend to have a connection with you, so it's important to stop and check, even when you are approached by what you may think is a trusted organisation.
